OVERALL PHILOSOPHY

1. Our overall philosophy is to build Godly character through skill development and competitive sports.
2. We will encourage our students to work hard to accomplish the goal (Colossians 3:23-- `Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men.`)
3. Our goal is not equal time for all athletes, nor is it to `win at all cost.` We will encourage winning as a team effort and an accomplishment to strive towards.
4. Participating in our athletic program is voluntary. It is a privilege that can be revoked.
5. We hope to glorify the Lord Jesus Christ in all our words, actions, and attitudes.

STUDENT ATHLETES-- CODE OF CONDUCT:

1. Eligibility rules: All participants must meet the eligibility requirements as defined by the SWCHA Saints program. Please see specific guidelines for homeschool, private school, Christian school, and "virtual school" students on the Saints website. Grade level should be considered as what is typical or the norm for an athlete of the same age.
2. We expect the athletes to conduct themselves in a Christian manner whether on the court, sitting the bench, or as a spectator.
3. They should respect and follow the directions of the coaches.
4. They should accept the calls of the officials graciously.
5. They should play hard trying to win in a sportsmanlike manner and to cheer in the same manner.
6. They should play as part of a team and not for self-glorification.
7. They should be a humble winner and a gracious loser.
8. They should be courteous and friendly to all opponents.
9. They should be respectful of all equipment and facilities (including proper uniform care).
10. They should attend all practices, games, fundraisers, and tournaments, unless excused by a parent.

PARENTS-- CODE OF CONDUCT:

1. Parents have the God-given responsibility over their children. If your child is enrolled in the athletic program, you are delegating some authority to the coach, but not the responsibility. We wish to maintain good communication regarding practices, games, and character issues.
2. Parents should conduct themselves in a Christian and sportsmanlike manner.
3. They should accept the official's decisions.
4. They should refrain from showing displeasure toward officials, players, coaches, and the opposing team.
5. They should accept a win or a loss in a Christian manner.
6. They should encourage teamwork, not self-glorification for one athlete.
7. They should support the commitment made to the team by getting the student to and from practices and games in a timely fashion, and by informing the coach regarding absences. They are also encouraged to participate in fund-raising events, to attend games, and to volunteer for tasks when needed.

CONFLICTS: We, too, are merely sinners trusting Jesus Christ for His gift of salvation. Therefore, we make mistakes. If you have any complaints or concerns, please handle the situation thusly. First, pray about the situation. Ask God for His direction in the matter. If necessary, speak one-on-one with the coach. If you are not yet satisfied, contact the athletic coordinator. Make certain your heart is right and that you are not sowing seeds of discord. As problems arise, we desire to settle the situation using Biblical principles.
